

2026 Wynn Millions Poker Series
General Terms and Conditions
February 16–March 22, 2026

1. These General Poker Tournament Terms and Conditions are meant to be read and followed in conjunction with Wynn's standard poker rules, and each individual Tournament event's (may be referred to as "Event" or collectively as a "Tournament") Terms and Conditions and Structure Sheet. In the event there is a conflict, these Terms and Conditions shall prevail.
2. Players and guests must be at least 21 years of age.
3. Registration for each Event will open four (4) hours prior to the scheduled start of play. Players will register in the Wynn Las Vegas Poker Room, located in Encore at Wynn Las Vegas.
4. The Tournament entry fee (the "Entry Fee") must be paid with cash or Wynn Las Vegas live casino chips; no other forms of payment will be accepted.
5. All Events will use Tournament chips for play. Tournament chips have no cash value, may not be used for any other purpose, and must be returned to Wynn Las Vegas at the end of each Event.
6. All Events will utilize the Big Blind Ante format unless otherwise noted on the Tournament structure sheet. In the event that the player in the big blind has less than the required amount to post both the big blind and the ante, the big blind will be posted first. The ante will then be posted with any remaining Tournament chips.
7. A redraw for seats will occur at the conclusion of each day for all multi-flight and multi-day Events, as well as when each tournament reaches the final table. All Events will redraw when the Event reaches the final table.
8. When the tournament reaches the final five (5) tables, the next table to "break" will be selected by random draw by the Tournament Director. This process will continue for each table thereafter until the final table redraw is reached.
9. Tournament chip stacks will be put into play at the start of the event for all registered players who have been issued a table and seat assignment. Players registered as an "alternate" will receive a seat assignment from the Tournament Staff when seating becomes available.
10. At the conclusion of the registration period, all paid entries (including alternates) who have yet to be seated will be assigned a seat and their Tournament chips will be put into play.
11. A player will forfeit their option to cancel (void) their entry once their Tournament chip stack has been put into play and will not be entitled to a refund.
12. Timely play is expected of all players, and stalling is not permitted. Intentional stalling in an effort to gain an advantage over the field is strictly prohibited and may result in a penalty, including during events that feature an Action Clock. The use of time extensions in unwarranted situations, specifically when players are approaching a pay jump, will be considered a stalling violation and may result in the forfeiture of all remaining time extension chips.
13. At the sole discretion of the Tournament Director, a single hand taking considerably longer to complete than the rest of the field, during which time one or more players at other tables are eliminated, resulting in a pay jump, will result in prize money being split evenly between all players eliminated during such time.
14. Winners will be paid in Wynn Las Vegas live casino chips.
15. Players will need to refer to each Event's structure sheet for applicable details including but not limited to the scheduled dates of play, start times, and other relevant structure information.
16. IRS Compliance requires each player provide a valid government issued ID and a social security number. Nonresident aliens are subject to 30% US Income Tax withholding. ITIN's are required for Treaty Country exemptions. Tax form W-2G will be issued to all players winning in excess of \$5,000, net of the applicable Tournament Entry Fee.
17. Wynn Las Vegas standard poker rules (found inside the Wynn Poker Room) and current standard TDA rules (found at <https://www.pokertda.com/poker-tda-rules/>) apply. Where there is a conflict, these Terms will prevail, followed by the Wynn Las Vegas standard poker rules, the terms specific to any Event, and the TDA rules, in that order.
18. Players are required to be a member of the Wynn Rewards program in order to participate in a Tournament. Wynn Rewards has its own terms and conditions. Please visit the Wynn Rewards desk for details.

19. Players and guests will be required to adhere to all applicable Wynn Las Vegas policies. Wynn Resorts requires appropriate and respectful interactions between our guests and employees in our resorts. Wynn Resorts reserves the right to trespass anyone exhibiting behavior, language or clothing that, at our discretion, is inconsistent with the Wynn Resorts behavior standards. The Wynn behavior standards and other applicable policies can be accessed at www.wynnlasvegas.com. In the event a player or their guests are prevented from accessing property as a result of such policies or trespassed from property for non-compliance with such policies, then player shall be prohibited from participating in the Event or Tournament series and will not be entitled to any prizes or gifts associated with the Event or Tournament series.
20. Wynn Las Vegas reserves the right to refuse entry to, or disqualify, any individual at any time before or during the Event or Tournament series for any reason in Wynn Las Vegas' sole discretion.
21. Players must be clearly identifiable at all times. Tournament staff may request a player to remove any material (sunglasses, hat, hood, or other facial cover) which inhibits their continuous identification or is a distraction to the other participants. Players are not allowed to wear sunglasses and a face cover at the same time.
22. Players who are unable to participate or are disqualified from an Event are not entitled to any refunds or payouts.
23. Wynn Las Vegas management reserves the right to revise, suspend, or cancel Events at its sole discretion, without prior notice or liability.
24. Prior to the start of the Tournament, players may be required to execute a Film, Videotape, and/or Photograph Release as a condition of participating in the Tournament. If a player fails to execute a Film, Videotape, and/or Photograph Release, Wynn reserves the right to refuse entry to such individual.
25. Participants are prohibited from using gaming charts or any other poker training tools in the Tournament Area while play is in progress. The "Tournament Area" is defined as the poker tables on which play is underway, as well as any adjacent walkways or spaces that are accessible to participants and in view of any table on which play is taking place. Any participant found to be using gaming charts or any other poker training tools will be penalized in Wynn Las Vegas' sole discretion, up to and including disqualification.
26. The use of gaming charts or other poker training tools by spectators, family, friends, or coaches of the participants in or around the Tournament Area for the purpose of relaying real time information, strategy, or coaching advice is expressly prohibited during tournament play. Additionally, participants may not receive strategy advice or coaching derived from charts or training tools (i.e., what hands should and should not be played in any given circumstance). Wynn Las Vegas reserves the right to limit discussion and/or remove spectators from the area, as well as issue penalties to participants up to and including disqualification for any violation, at its sole discretion.
27. Scheduled breaks, as outlined by the tournament structure, fall outside of tournament play.
28. At the Tournament Director's discretion, Wynn Las Vegas reserves the right to limit the use of electronic devices including, but not limited to cellular phones, headphones, earbuds, or wearable technology (e.g., smartwatches) at any time.
29. Eyewear that features an electronic component, which includes wireless or Bluetooth capabilities, are expressly prohibited. Any participant found wearing such eyewear, regardless of whether the electronic components and/or features are in use or powered on, will be penalized in Wynn Las Vegas' sole discretion, up to and including disqualification.
30. All electronic devices, including those outlined above as well as those not expressly defined, will not be permitted when the tournament has reached the final three (3) tables. Electronic devices must be stowed and not accessed by the participant while at the table, however, may be used outside of the Tournament Area provided they are not being used for the purpose of violating the previous stipulations outlined above.
31. During the final three (3) tables of play, and all other timeframes during which the Tournament Director has limited or restricted the use of electronic devices, hooded sweatshirts and other apparel may not be worn in a manner that covers a participant's ears.
32. Filming or streaming live action or participant's hole cards by participants and spectators is prohibited without prior authorization from Wynn Las Vegas Management. Any participant found to be in violation may be penalized in Wynn Las Vegas' sole discretion, up to and including disqualification.
33. The Tournament series and these Terms and Conditions are subject to Nevada Revised Statutes 463.362-463.3668 and Nevada Gaming Commission Regulation 7A and, subject thereto, all decisions made by Wynn Las Vegas shall be deemed final.

Tournament Action Clock General Terms and Conditions

1. Dealers will initiate the start of the Tournament Action Clock upon the completion of the deal. Time will begin for a player once the natural flow of play has come to a brief pause pending their action and be reset to the corresponding time for the next player to act.
2. Players will have fifteen (15) seconds on their Action Clock preflop, unless otherwise specified on the official tournament structure sheet.
3. Once a player has voluntarily placed chips into the pot, the Tournament Action Clock will increase to thirty (30) seconds for each subsequent action of that player until the hand has concluded.
4. The small and big blind are forced bets and are not considered voluntary.
5. When a bet or raise has been made, the dealer will count and announce the bet or raise (including All In bets) prior to starting the Action Clock for the next player.
6. To facilitate the smooth operation of the tournament, all tournament chips must remain in full stacks of twenty (20) chips, when available.
7. When breaking a table or moving a player to another table, a player must keep their time extensions and tournament chips in plain view while traveling to their new seat.
8. Each time extension will add an additional thirty (30) seconds to act.
9. Players will receive time extension chips at predetermined stages (set level or remaining number of players) as outlined below for each specific event.
10. Players are required to keep all time extension chips visible and on the table at all times.
11. Players will automatically lose one (1) time extension each time the Action Clock reaches zero (0), and will be instructed by the dealer to turn in the corresponding amount of time extensions used at the completion of their action. Players are not responsible for placing a time extension chip into the pot in real time.
12. In the event that a player does not have any time extensions remaining and the Action Clock reached zero (0), the player's hand will be declared dead (or the player will be forced to check if facing no action).
13. Once implemented, the Tournament Action Clock will be used until the completion of the event and will not be suspended.
14. At the conclusion of play each day, any unused time extension chips will be placed in the players' tournament chip bag and will carry over to the next tournament day. Time extensions are to be treated with the same level of importance as tournament chips, and removal of time extensions may be subject to penalty up to and including disqualification.

This \$600 No Limit Hold'em \$200,000 Guaranteed poker tournament (the "Tournament") is a two-day No Limit Hold'em event.

Day 1A: Wednesday, February 18, 2026 at 12 p.m.

Day 1B: Thursday, February 19, 2026 at 12 p.m.

Day 2: Friday, February 20, 2026 at 12 p.m.

Entry Fee: \$600 Buy-in = \$510 (Tournament Prize Pool) + \$65 (Tournament Fee) + \$25 (Poker Staff Service Charge)

Registration:

Unlimited re-entry for each starting flight will be available until the start of level 10 (approximately 6:45 p.m.). A player who advances to Day 2 is prohibited from entering a subsequent starting flight. A player that has advanced to Day 2 who enters a starting flight in error will be disqualified from the subsequent flight and will not be entitled to a refund of their Tournament re-entry fee. The player will be permitted to play Day 2 with their Tournament chip stack from the original starting flight.

Starting Stack:

Players will start with 40,000 in tournament chips.

Length of Play:

Day 1: 40 minutes per level until 12.5% or less of the field remains.

Day 2: 40 minutes per level until a winner is declared.

Breaks:

15-minute break every 3 levels of play.

Players Per Table:

Tables will play 9-handed.

The Final Table will begin 9-handed.

Payouts:

Each Day 1 will play until 12.5% or less of the field remains. At the beginning of Day 2, the Tournament clock will resume at the earliest finishing time at which play ended in any of the previous starting flights.

Only players who advance to Day 2 will be considered "in the money". The Tournament prize pool will be calculated at the conclusion of the final starting flight based on the number of players who advance to Day 2.

Action Clock:

The Action Clock will be put into play on each Day 1, at the conclusion of level 15 or at the tournament directors' discretion. Each player will receive three (3) time extensions when the Action Clock is put into play. Each player will receive three (3) additional time extension chips on the first scheduled break of Day 2. Each player will receive three (3) additional time extension chips when twenty-seven (27) players remain. Each player will receive three (3) additional time extension chips when nine (9) players remain. See Action Clock rules for details.

This \$200 Milestone Satellite to \$1,100 No Limit Hold'em \$500,000 Guaranteed poker tournament (the "Tournament") is a single day No Limit Hold'em event. This event will be offered on the following days:

- Thursday March 12, 2026 at 6 p.m.
- Friday March 13, 2025 at 6 p.m.

Direct Entry: At the conclusion of each event, prize winners will be directly registered into the *\$1,100 NLH \$500,000 GTD Poker Tournament*. Upon registration, winners will receive a seat assignment, and their chips will be put into play from the start of the event.

Winners of any Milestone Satellite beginning at 6 p.m. will have the option to be directly registered into the following flight or the flight directly thereafter (Example: Winners of the evening satellite held on Day 1A would be given the choice of Day 1B or Day 1C).

Should a player who has won multiple event entries via satellite reach Day 2, it is their sole responsibility to contact the Tournament Director, in writing, prior to the scheduled starting time of the following starting flight to request tournament credit for any unused entries. Failure to do so will result in the chips being put into play, and the loss of the satellite entry and subsequent tournament credit.

Entry Fee: \$200 Buy-in = \$165 (Tournament Prize Pool) + \$20 (Tournament Fee) + \$15 (Poker Staff Service Charge)

Registration: Unlimited re-entry will be available until the start of level 9.

Starting Stack: Players will start with 20,000 in tournament chips.

Length of Play: 20 minutes per level until completion.

Breaks: 10-minute break every 4 levels of play.

Players Per Table:

Tables will play 9-handed.

The Final Table will begin 9-handed.

Payouts:

The Tournament Prize will be one (1) direct entry seat into the *\$1,100 NLH \$500,000 GTD Poker Tournament* to be held on March 12-14, 2026. The total number of available Tournament Prizes will be based on the total number of Entry Fees received. One (1) Tournament Prize, valued at \$1,100, will be generated for every 6.7 Entry Fees received (the "Tournament Prize Formula"). A minimum of 5 direct entry seats into the *\$1,100 NLH \$500,000 GTD Poker Tournament* will be awarded.

A Player who accumulates 140,000 in tournament chips ("The Milestone") or more will instantly be awarded one (1) Tournament Prize. Upon verification from the tournament supervisor that the player has achieved the Milestone, the player will cease play and the total of his/her chips will be removed from play.

The Tournament will conclude when the number of players remaining is equal to the number of \$1,100 prizes generated based on the Tournament Prize Formula, less the amount of players who have previously won the prize by reaching the Milestone. Any Tournament prize pool residual funds, less than a full \$1,100 prize, will be paid in Wynn Las Vegas casino chips to the last player eliminated prior to the conclusion of the Tournament.

Milestone Rules:

While the tournament staff will make the best effort to identify players as they achieve the Milestone, it is the responsibility of each individual entrant to notify the dealer or Tournament Supervisor when they have reached 140,000 in tournament chips.

A player who is dealt into a subsequent hand after achieving the Milestone will be required to complete the hand prior to being awarded the Tournament Prize. If, at the completion of the additional hand, a players' chip total falls below the Milestone they are not eligible to receive the Tournament Prize until their chip total is once again equal to or greater than 140,000.

A Tournament Supervisor must be called to verify the tournament chip count of a player who is making a claim for a Tournament Prize. Players may request that a Tournament Supervisor count their stack at any time between hands.

A player who assists another in counting their chip stack or notifying them that they have reached the Milestone is not in breach of the rules.

To facilitate the smooth operation of the tournament, all tournament chips must remain in full stacks of twenty (20) chips when available.

Any form of collusion, including the removal of tournament chips from the table, may result in penalty up to and including disqualification.

Players who have already advanced to Day 2, have an unused satellite ticket, or have already registered for Day 1C are not eligible to participate.
